

The below information is from a monument that was dedicated May 8, 1999 at the Stonewall Jackson Camp #249 near Holliday, Texas. The monument contains the names of 160 Confederate Veterans who attended the annual reunions from 1885 through 1920. The camp was first located 2 miles south of Archer City at Three Forks of the Little Wichita River and in 1897 at the newly purchased camp ground near Holliday. The camp is located 1-1/2 miles south of Holliday (Archer County) on Farm to Market Road 368.
